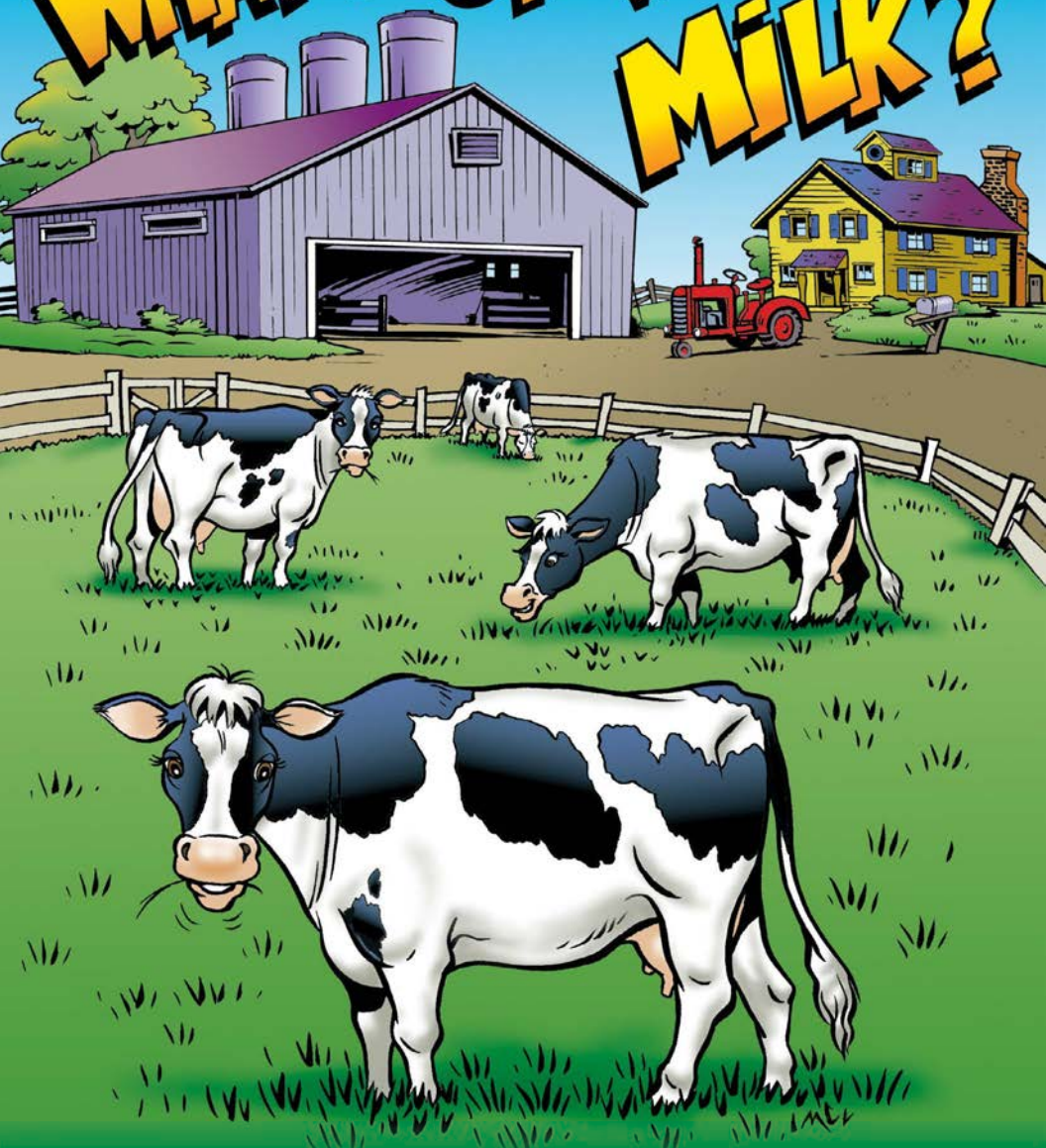
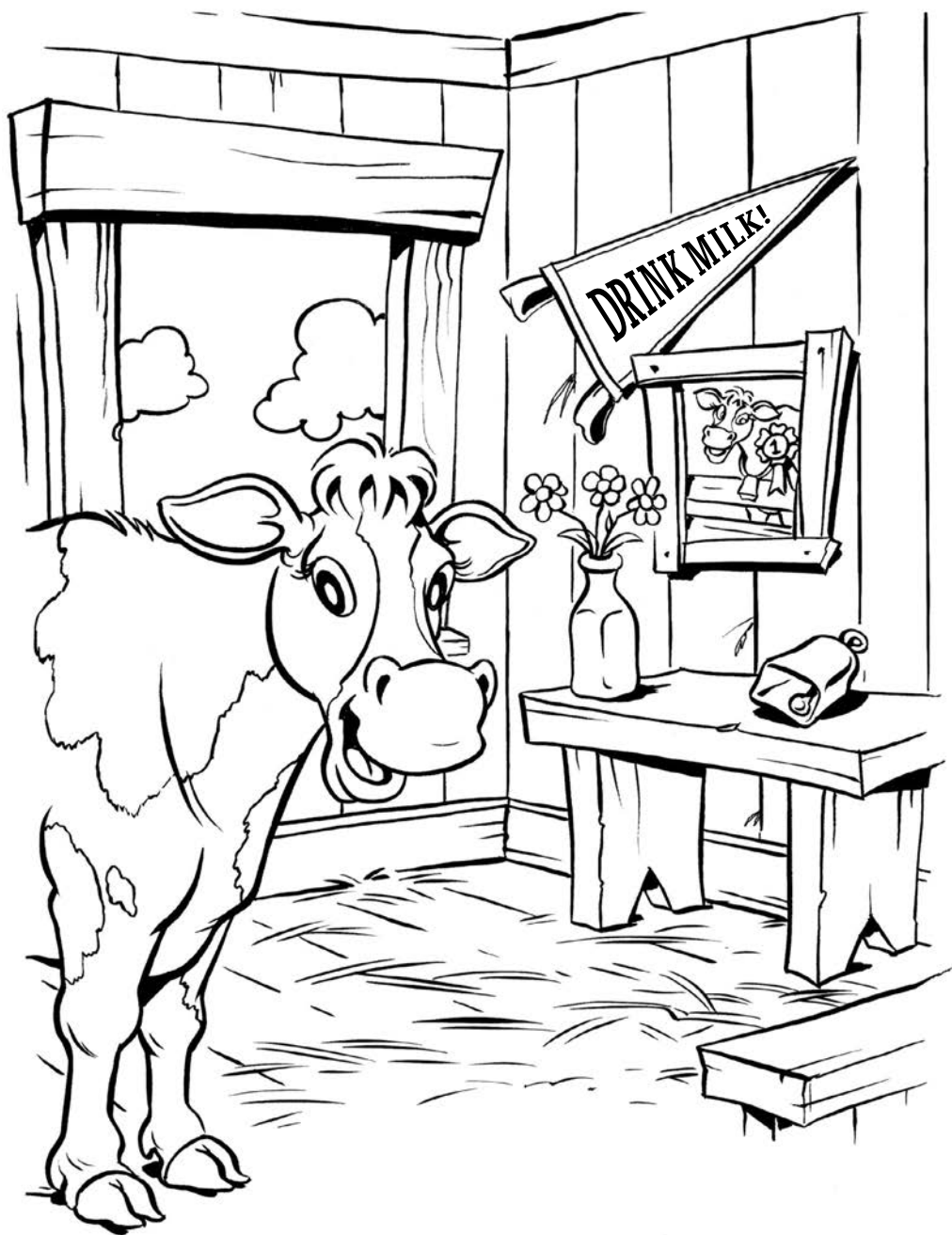

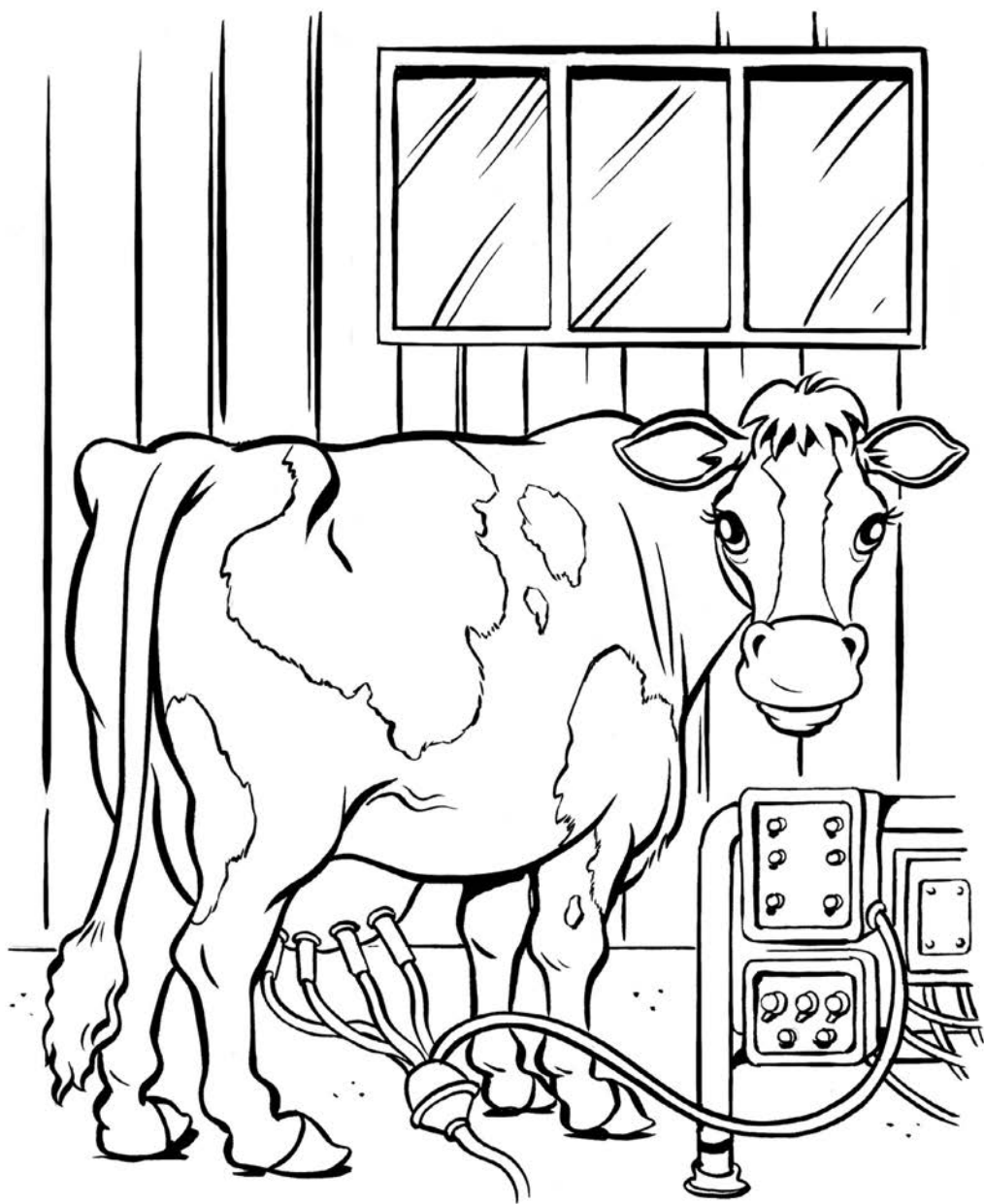




My farmer gives me a clean,

and other dairy products.



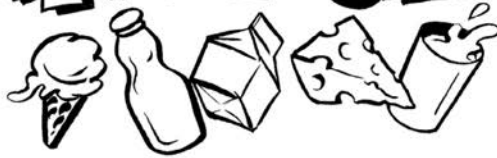
You can buy the foods made with

you plenty of energy.

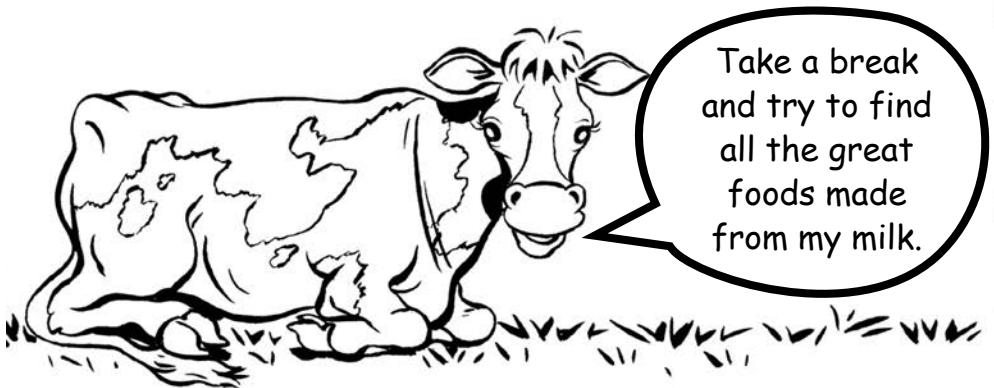
